



Project: *Reed Street Railroad Bridge*

Location: *Norwalk, Connecticut*

A.DiCesare Associates provided Construction Engineering and Inspection services for the construction of the Reed Street Railroad Bridge along the Danbury Branch Line of Metro-North Railroad. This project provided a new railroad bridge through an existing railroad embankment. The new roadway underneath the new bridge links the Norwalk River waterfront with the multi-million dollar Reed-Putnam redevelopment in Norwalk, CT. The value of this construction contract was approximately \$10,000,000.

Professional staff included personnel trained by the New England Transportation Technician Certification Program (NETTCP) for Hot-Mixed Asphalt, Soils & Aggregates, and Concrete Placement.

Multiple phases of construction staging were required to maintain railroad traffic. Extensive coordination with the Connecticut Department of Transportation and Metro-North Railroad was required. These were the key components to the success of the project.
